SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 272

(Senate Bill 203)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 603 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Sabbath Breaking," allowing the operation of motion picture theatres in Kent County on Sunday, except that within the corporate limits of Chestertown, no such theatre shall be operated before 2 P. M. Sunday.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 603 of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Sabbath Breaking," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

603. Nothing contained in Section 578 of this Article, however, shall be construed as prohibiting, penalizing or making unlawful the operation of any *motion picture theatre*, bowling alley, tenpin alley or duckpin alley in Kent County on Sunday, with or without a charge or fee, except that within the corporate limits of Chestertown, no such alley or theatre shall be operated before 2 P. M. on Sunday.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
