SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 293

(Senate Bill 424)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 37B (a) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", said section having been amended by Chapter 559 of the Acts of 1951, increasing the number of deputy Sheriffs of Allegany County and relating generally to the appointment and salaries of said deputies.

WHEREAS, in the report of the Allegany County Grand Jury for the January Term, 1951, attention was called to the fact that the office of the Sheriff of Allegany County was under-staffed; and

Whereas, for this reason, it is desirable to provide an increase in the number of Deputy Sheriffs of Allegany County; therefore

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland That Section 37B (a) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", said section having been amended by Chapter 559 of the Acts of 1951, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

37B.

(a) The Sheriff of Allegany County shall receive an annual salary of *not less than* \$4,000.

The Sheriff [may] shall appoint [four (4)] five (5) deputies at an annual salary of not less than \$3,000 \$3,300
