CHAPTER 308

(Senate Bill 514)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 38 (m) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", relating to the salary of the sheriff of Howard County and the appointment and salary of a chief deputy and a deputy sheriff.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 38 (m) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted. with amendments, and to read as follows:

38.

- (m) The Sheriff of Howard County shall receive an annual salary of [\$2,500.] \$3,000. He shall appoint a Chief Deputy who shall receive an annual salary of \$2,000, and a Deputy who shall receive an annual salary of \$1,600. The Deputies shall provide their own automobiles. It wo deputy sheriffs who shall each receive an annual salary of \$1,500 and who shall provide their own automobiles. He may also apoint temporarily such additional deputy sheriffs as he may deem necessary for the public safety and the County Commissioners shall allow reasonable compensation for same, but such deputies shall not serve longer than the case actually warrants.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect December 1, 1954.
