SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 38 (1) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

38.

(1) The Sheriff of Harford County shall receive an annual salary of ~~[\$3,600]~~ \$5,000. He shall appoint such deputies and at such compensation as may be provided by the County Commissioners of said County.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953, and shall not apply to the present incumbent.

## CHAPTER 333

(House Bill 415)

AN ACT to repeal Section 84A of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Charlestown", and to enact in lieu thereof a new section to be known as Section 84A, to follow immediately after Section 84 of said Article, relating to the qualifications and election of the Commissioners of Charlestown.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 84A of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Charlestown", be and it is hereby repealed and that a new section be and it is hereby enacted in
