- (j) The County Treasurer of Garrett County shall receive an annual salary of \$4,500.00, out of which he shall pay for any assistants or clerks, but the County Commissioners of said County shall allow the said Treasurer \$200.00 annually for the expense of secretarial services in making out tax bills [.] , and an additional \$250.00 annually for the expense of an attorney; provided that the attorney to the County Commissioners shall be the attorney to the County Treasurer.
