(j) The County Treasurer of Garrett County shall receive an annual salary of \$4,500.00, out of which he shall pay for any assistants or clerks, but the County Commissioners of said County shall allow the said Treasurer \$200.00 annually for the expense of secretarial services in making out tax bills [.] , and an additional \$250.00 annually for the expense of an attorney; provided that the attorney to the County Commissioners shall be the attorney to the County Treasurer.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 451

(Senate Bill 523)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 142 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County," sub-title "County Commissioners and Treasurer," and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 201 of said Article, as said section was amended by Chapter 359 of the Acts of 1933; relating to the annual salary of the County Commissioners of Dorchester County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 142 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County," sub-title "County Commissioners and Treasurer," and Section 201 of said Article, as said section was amended by Chapter 359 of the Acts of 1933, be and they are
