SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (g) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys In Fact," sub-title "State's Attorney," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and that a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to said section, said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (g-b) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (g-a) of said section and all to read as follows:

40.

(g) The State's Attorneys of **[Carroll,]** Dorchester and Frederick Counties shall each receive an annual salary of \$3,600.

(g-b) The State's Attorney of Carroll County shall receive an annual salary of \$4,250.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 455

(Senate Bill 529)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 234 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County (1948 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Orphans' Court and Register of Wills", said section having been amended by Chapter 573 of the Acts of 1951, providing for an expense account for the Appraiser and Deputy Appraiser of the Orphans'
