CHAPTER 456

(Senate Bill 531)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 234 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County", sub-title "Foxes," as said Section was amended by Chapter 53 of the Acts of 1951, making it unlawful to kill or injure any red fox when pursued by dogs in Queen Anne's County.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 234 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County", sub-title "Foxes," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

- 234. It shall not be lawful to kill or injure any *red* fox in Queen Anne's County, when pursued by dogs or to shoot or shoot at any dog while pursuing a fox in Queen Anne's County.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
