CHAPTER 469

(Senate Bill 574)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (E) of Section 349 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1943 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Cottage City", providing for the time at which the Board of Election Supervisors of Prince George's County shall conduct a registration of the voters of Cottage City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-section (E) of Section 349 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1943 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Cottage City", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

349.

(E) Said Board shall, on the first Monday in April, if not a legal holiday, and if a legal holiday then on the day following, [and also on the second Monday in April, if not a legal holiday, and if a legal holiday then on the day following,] conduct a registration of the qualified voters of said town.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
