

give bond to the Town of Cottage City in the amount authorized by the Commissioners for the faithful performance of his duties, and shall have attained the age of twenty-one years and shall hold such position for such time as The Cottage City Commission shall determine. Such [bailiff or bailiffs] police may at any time be removed from such position by resolution of The Cottage City Commission.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.*

CHAPTER 471

(Senate Bill 580)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 136 (a) of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Dorchester County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", being also codified as Section 29 of Article 20 of said Code, title "Somerset County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", Section 20 of Article 23 of said Code, title "Wicomico County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", and Section 49 of Article 24 of said Code, title "Worcester County", sub-title "Circuit Court", sub-heading "Court Stenographer", as said sections were amended by Chapter 649 of the Acts of 1949, increasing the salary of the Court Stenographer of the First Judicial Circuit.
