CHAPTER 46

(Senate Bill 132)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments. Sections 1237 and 1239 and Sub-section 1241(h), said Section 1237 having been amended by Chapter 367 of the Acts of 1951, and said Sub-section 1241(h) having been amended by Chapter 91 of the Acts of 1947 and Chapter 367 of the Acts of 1951, and to add a new section to the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County. (1943 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Seat Pleasant", said new Section to be known as Section 1246 A and to follow immediately after Section 1246 of said Article; changing the voting hours in effect for the election of officers of the Town of Seat Pleasant and allowing compensation to election judges and Clerks, providing for the bonding of the Treasurer of the said Town at the Town's expense, increasing the permissible bonded indebtedness of said Town, authorizing the Mayor and Common Council of the said Town to construct and maintain a storm water drainage system within said Town, to issue bonds to finance such construction, to assess the cost of such construction against the properties benefited, to defray up to 25% of said cost by the use of general funds of the town and to defray said cost by the use of contributions from the Washington Suburban Sanitary District and generally amending the Charter of the Town of Seat Pleasant. and providing for a referendum thereon.
