Federal Census or by an official local census, whichever is latest.

Every individual resident of Maryland making an income tax return under this sub-title shall be required to state on the tax return form furnished by the Comptroller the name of the County and the name of the incorporated city, town or village municipality in which he resides.

The remainder of the taxes collected shall be paid into the general treasury of the State and distributed therefrom, in the manner and for the purposes set forth in the Budget.

SEC. 6. And be it further enacted, That Sub-section (b) of Section 22 of Article 89B of said Code, title "State Roads," sub-title "Distribution and Use of Special Funds," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

22.

- (b). If any municipality which is authorized by law to construct or maintain streets or roads shall request the State Roads Commission in writing not later than thirty days prior to the beginning of any State fiscal year for its share of the funds distributable under this section, the State Roads Commission during such fiscal year shall allocate for the county or such municipality a portion of the share as first determined in Sub-section (a) hereof of the county within which the municipality lies. Such portion shall be determined by the proportion which the total mileage of county roads in the municipality bears to the total mileage of county roads in such county. The portion so determined shall be the municipality's share for the purpose of this section. In the distribution of the shares pursuant to this sub-division, the special improvement districts in Prince George's County IN EXISTENCE ON JANUARY 1, 1953, shall be treated as municipalities, but the payments made hereunder shall be retained by the County Commissioners of said county as credits to said districts, and shall be applied toward the cost of maintenance of such streets and roads in the said districts so long as it has an indebtedness.1
- SEC. 7. And be it further enacted, That a new section be added to Article 56 of said Code, title "Licenses", subtitle "Mode of Issuing-General Provisions", to be known as Section 3A, to follow immediately after Section 3 of said Article and to read as follows:
