f the person or persons intrusted by the company with the care and superintendence of such part if the said road as shall be found defective, and if the said person or persons intrusted by the company aforesaid, shall be convicted of the offence by the said inquisition charged, the said court shall not the said person or persons according to the nature and aggravation of the neglect, in their discretion, not exceeding one hundred dollars for every week such place shall have been out of order and repair; and in case the said company should neglect to have the said place repaired within fifteen they after the aforesaid fine shall have been laid, then the said court shall proceed to fine the said resident, managers and company, in their discretion, not exceeding two hundred dollars, for the last of the county, under the direction of the levy court.

XXI. And BE IT ENACTED, That if any person or persons whomsoever, riding in or driving any aulkey, chair or chaise, phæton, cart, wagon, wain, sleigh, sled, or other carriage of burthen or bleasure, riding or leading any horse, mare or gelding, or driving any hogs, sheep or cattle, shall herewith pass through any private gate or bars, or along or over any private gates or bars, or along or over any private passage way, or other ground near to or adjoining any turnpike gate which hall be erected in pursuance of this act, with an intent to defraud the company and avoid the payment of the toll or duty for passing through any such gate or turnpike, or if any person or persons hall, with such intent, take off, or cause to be taken off, any horse, mare or gelding, or other cat-Le, from any wagon or carriage of butthen or pleasure, or practise any other fraudulent means or evice, with the intent that the payment of any such tolls or duty may be evaded or lessened, all and every person or persons, in all, every or any of the ways or manners aforesaid offending, shall, for every such offence respectively, forfeit and pay to the said president, managers and company, of the road on which said fraud shall or may be practised, any sum not exceeding ten dollars, to be sued for and recovered, with costs of suit, before any justice of the peace, in like manner as debts of a smilar amount may be sued for and recovered; provided always, that if any person or persons shall be prosecuted under this section, and the said prosecution shall not be sustained on the part of the prosecutor, then and in such case the person or persons prosecuted as aforesaid shall receive from he company the sum of twenty dollars, in lieu of damages from delay and vexatious prosecution, ecoverable as other fines under this act; and if any toll-gatherer shall knowingly demand and receive any greater toll from any person or persons than such toll-gatherer is authorised to demand and accive by virtue of this act, such toll-gatherer shall forfeit and pay the sum of twenty dollars for every such offence, to the use of the county in which the forfeiture is incurred, and for the payment of which the said company shall be responsible.

XXII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the president and managers of the said company shall keep air and just accounts of all monies received by them from the said commissioners, and from the subentirers to the said undertakings on account of the several subscriptions, and of all penalties for dey in payment thereof, and of the amount of the profits on the shares which may be forfeited as
