CHAPTER 169.

Passed March An act to allow James W. Saulsbury, late Collector of 3, 1845. Caroline County, further time to complete his collections.

Time allowed. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, James W. Saulsbury, late collector of Caroline county, by himself or any person or persons by him appointed, for this purpose, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect until the last day of December, eighteen hundred and forty-five, all sums and balances due him as collector of said county, in the same manner which the said James W. Saulsbury could, or might have done within the time now limited by law, any thing to the contrary
