SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated. Maryland, That James M. Lester, John W. Carter, Joseph B. Stewart, N. D. Ruckle, Jacob Parrish, A. T. Waugh, John Showacre, David Whitson, jr., Charles T. Collins, A. J. Fairbanks, James B. Stewart, Maria Hartman, Margaret Stewart, Mary A. Parker, Isabella Ready, Maria McCausland, Eleanor Ward, S. Windstanly, and their successors, be and they are hereby declared to be a community, corporation and body politic, by the name, style and title aforesaid, and by that name shall be capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended, in all or any courts of justice, and before all and any judge, officers or persons whatsoever, in all and singular actions, matter or demands whatsoever.
