CHAP. 21.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter two hundred and eighty-five. Passed Jan. 21, 1845.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the legal title of the said society or body corporate, shall henceforth be the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference. Name, style and title.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the managers of the said society, and their successors henceforth in office, by their said corporate name shall be persons capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, and issue all legal process in any court of law or equity, or before any judge, officer or other person or persons whatever, either within or without the limits of the said State, and to purchase, take, hold and enjoy to and for themselves and their successors, any estate or interest whatever, in lands chattels, rents, annuities, bank stock, registered debts, public or private securities, or other real or personal property within or without the said State, by deed, assignment, devise, bequest or other mode of conveyance or transfer, of or from any person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, having legal capacity to make such transfer or conveyance, and the same, at their pleasure, to improve, lease, rent, incumber, dispose of, or alien in such manner as they may judge most conducive to the benevolent purpose of said society; *provided,* that their entire property or estate, shall at no time exceed in value the sum of forty thousand dollars. Incorporated. Proviso.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That so much of the said act of incorporation as is inconsistent with the provisions of this supplement be, and the same is hereby repealed; *provided nevertheless,* that all the proceedings of said society heretofore had and adopted, shall be as effectual and valid to every intent as though this supplemental act had not been passed; *and provided further,* that nothing herein contained is intended to interfere with the provisions of the second, fifth and sixth sections of the said act, of which this is a supplement.
