Judicial Districts.

Section I. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Causes in e-Maryland, That where causes in equity have been or quity removshall hereafter be removed to the court of chancery, from any county courts, and where the said court of chancery has determined, or shall determine, that it cannot receive or proceed with such causes, the said court may remand the same to the respective county courts, to be there proceeded with in manner and to every effect as if no removal had taken place.

SEC 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall go into In force after operation from and immediately after the passage thereof. its passage.
