**ILLEGAL VOTING.**—Any person offering to vote, not being a citizen of United States, 12 months in the State, and six months preceding election a resident, &c. guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction subject to fine of not less than \$50, nor more than \$500, and imprisonment not less than one month nor more than 2 years. 309 1

Any person bribing or offering to bribe a legal voter, subject to same fine and imprisonment as aforesaid. " 2

Any person voting without qualification of age and residence, as now required, upon conviction, subject to the punishment prescribed in the 1st section, &c. " 3

Any person voting or offering to vote on certificates of naturalization of any other person, to be guilty of felony, and on conviction to be confined in the Penitentiary not less than two nor more than six years. " 4
