Commissioners of, required to cause the gates upon a certain road mentioned in the act of 1843, ch. 306, to be removed within six months after the passage of the act. 142

The 2nd section of the act of 1842, ch. 298, to incorporate the Hopewell academy in, repealed. 143 1

The trustees named in 1st section of said act to fill vacancies in the board. 2

The fees due the attorneys and officers of, the court of, and register of wills of, to be delivered to sheriff for collection on or before 1st May, sheriff to have power to collect, no distress to be levied unless accounts delivered before 1st September, sheriff not required to pay said fees before 1st January. 174 1

Official bond of sheriff may be sued, on failure to pay over said fees on or before 1st January. 2

Sheriff of, to make out fees due him at any time before 1st May, no distress to be levied unless accounts delivered before 1st day of Sept. fees due out of the county, to be delivered before 1st June. 3

Nothing in this act to apply to fees not now required to be placed in the hands of the sheriff of, before 1st March. 4

Commissioners of, to allow treasurer of the school fund of, 2 per cent. out of said fund upon the amount of money annually received by him under original act as a compensation for receiving said fund. 175 1

So much of 3d section of act of 1841, ch. 80, as authorises the commissioners to compensate said treasurer the use for a limited time of a part of said fund for his own benefit repealed. 2

Inconsistent acts repealed. 3
