CHAP. 73. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall continue in force thirty years.

CHAPTER 72.

Passed Feb. 12, 1845. *An act further to continue an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Towing Company.*

Act of 1831 extended. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Towing Company, passed at December session, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, together with every supplement thereto, be and the same is hereby continued until the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, and to the end of the next session of the legislature which shall happen thereafter.

Right reserved. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly retains to itself the power at any time to alter, change or repeal this act.

CHAPTER 73.

Passed Feb. 13, 1845. *An act for the relief of Mary Hasson and James Lile, of Cecil County.*

Commissioners to levy. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the county commissioners of Cecil county, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to levy annually upon the assessable property of said county, the sum of twenty dollars, to be paid to such person as the said commissioner shall direct, for the use, maintenance and support of Mary Hasson, an aged, indigent and infirm female, a citizen of Cecil county.

Levy annually for support. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners of Cecil county be, and they are hereby further authorised and empowered, to levy annually upon the assessable property of said county, the sum of fifteen dollars, to be paid to such person as the said commissioners shall direct, for the use, maintenance and support of James Lile, an indigent and infirm citizen of the said county.
