CHAPTER 85.

An act entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and five. Passed Feb. 14, 1845.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, oral testimony made on affirmation of the identity of the grantor or grantors in any deed or deeds or other instrument of writing, shall be as good and sufficient, as if the same was taken under oath, as by the fourth section of the act to which this is a supplement is required; *provided*, the certificate of such affirmation, before the justices of the peace taking the same as hereinbefore directed, shall appear in the acknowledgment by them made to such deed or deeds or other instruments in the same manner as is now required of the oath of identity, by the act to which this is a supplement. CHAPTER 86.

An act to confirm an act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government of this State, prohibiting any money being drawn from the Treasury of the State, but in consequence of appropriations made by law. Passed Feb. 14, 1845.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and thirty-nine, entitled, an act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government of this State, prohibiting any money being drawn from the Treasury of the State, but in consequence of appropriations made by law, be and the same is hereby confirmed.
