CHAPTER 90.

An act for the benefit of John Usilton, of Kent County.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Proceedings That all further proceedings upon a judgment in Kent suspended uncounty court, rendered at September term, in the year next. eighteen hundred and forty-four, in the name of the State of Maryland, against John Usilton, and his securities, on his bond, as collector of the direct tax, for the years eighteen hundred and forty-one, and eighteen hundred and forty-two, be suspended until the first day of August next, after the passage of this act; provided however, the said se-provisoes. curities shall file in the clerk's office of said county, their written assent to the provisions of this act, on or before the first day of May next; and provided further, that this State reserves to itself all the remedies against the said sureties, now held by it, notwithstanding the provisions of this act.
