more, to bring into this State, from the State of Virginia, CHAP. 103. a negro slave, named Georgiana; provided, she comply Proviso. with the last proviso of the fourth section of the act of Assembly, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter three hundred and twenty-three, and also, the requisitions of the act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter eightyseven, and also, the requirements of the act of Assembly, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirtynine, chapter fifteen.

CHAPTER 103.

An act authorising a reduction of the maximum charge for Passed Passengers on the Washington Branch of the Baltimore 13, 1845. Passed Feb. and Ohio Rail Road, as at present established.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of After 1st June Maryland, That from and after the first day of June next, fare from Balt. the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, be and they lowered. are hereby authorised to reduce the rate of tolls for passengers, from time to time in their discretion, upon the Washington Branch of said road, by carrying them to and from the respective cities of Washington and Baltimore, for a less sum than is now authorised; provided, that the charge for a passenger to and from the said cities, shall not be less than one dollar and fifty cents; and provided always, that one-fifth of all such passage money so received be accounted for, and paid into the State Treasury as now required by law.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Baltimore and Authorised to Ohio Rail Road Company be, and they are hereby autho-transport passengers, &c. rised to transport passengers on the said Washington road to and from the respective cities of Washington and Baltimore, in companies not less than twenty, for a less sum than is now authorised, in cases where such passengers shall perform the trip to and from the two cities, within the period of three days; provided always, that one-fifth part of all such passage money so received, be accounted for and paid into the State Treasury as aforesaid.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said Baltimore and Way passen-Ohio Rail Road Company, shall also, be authorised and gers in prorequired to transport way passengers upon the said Wash-portion. ington Branch, in proportion to the charge from city to city, with the same proviso and subject to the same condition as is expressed in the first and second sections of this act, with regard to passengers from city to city.
