Passed Feb. An act to reduce the county expenses of Carroll County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Justices of the Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, to receive \$1. each of the justices of the Orphans' court of Carroll coun- 50 cts per day. ty, shall receive an allowance of one dollar and fifty cents per day, and no more, for each and every day he shall be present and act during the session of said court, and six Six and a quarand a quarter cents, and no more, per mile as itinerant ter cents as icompensation, from his place of residence in the said county to the town of Westminster in the county aforesaid, to attend to the business of said court.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the commissioners of Commissioners to receive the tax for Carroll county, shall be entitled to receive one \$1 50 per day. dollar and fifty cents each, and no more, for each and every day they shall necessarily attend to the duties of their office, and six and a quarter cents, and no more per Six and a quarmile, as itinerant compensation from their place of resi- ter cents as idence in the county, to the town of Westminster, and the clerk to the said commissioners shall be entitled to receive Clerk not to such sum annually, for his services as the said commis-receive over sioners may allow, not exceeding the sum of three hun- \$300 a year. dred dollars per annum.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the judges and clerks Judges and of elections in Carroll county, shall each of them be al-clerks of eleclowed for every election at which they respectively attend tons, to reper and act as judges or clerks as aforesaid, and for making day. the returns of the said elections, the sum of two dollars per day and no more, to be levied and paid as other county charges.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the sheriff of Carroll Sheriff allowcounty, shall be entitled to receive twenty cents per day day as jail fees. and no more, for boarding persons in jail.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That all laws inconsistent Repealed. with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the act entitled, an act for the benefit of the crier of Carroll county court, passed December session eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter three hundred and eleven, be and the same is hereby repealed.
