An act to incorporate the Saint Michael's Beneficial Society, in Talbot County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated. Maryland, That Robert A. Dodson, Josiah Thomas, Oliver P. Sparks, Samuel Blades, John W. Barwick, Leonidas Dodson, Thomas K.
