CHAPTER 109.

An act relating to the Bank of Baltimore. Passed Jan.
8, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of* Advertise and
Maryland, That the President, Directors, and Company hold elections.
of the Bank of Baltimore, be and they are hereby author-
ised and empowered to advertise and hold their elections,
to elect their directors and president, and to make their
semi-annual dividends, in the manner and at the times
