And be it enacted, That in all cases CHAP. 125. where any sheriff, coroner or elisor, shall die having in In case officer his hands at the time of his death any writ of ca. sa. and die. such sheriff, coroner or elisor, shall have returned said writ cepi, without any further proceedings being had thereon, or shall have omitted to make any return to said writ, then and in that case the plaintiff or plaintiffs shall be entitled to issue an alias writ of ca. sa. to the sheriff or other proper officer for the time being, to the same extent and in the same manner as if said sheriff, coroner or elisor had not died.
