CHAP. 135.

An act for the opening and extension of Chew street in the city of Baltimore.

Passed Feb. 20, 1846.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to open and extend Chew street in said city, from the west side of Stirling street, to the east side of Britton street, to intersect at or near Neighbour street.

Open and extend street.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Mayor and City Council be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to appoint commissioners, and to provide by ordinance, for the assessment of damages and benefits, and to perform all other acts necessary to effect such opening and extension; provided, they shall consider it expedient so to open the said street.

CHAPTER 135.
