Treasurer not SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of to pay money to any person, Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, &c. when in the Treasurer upon demand being made upon him by any debted to the person or persons, or corporate bodies, having a claim or claims against the State due to him, them or it, in his, their or its own right, the said Treasurer is authorised and required, if such person or persons or corporation is indebted to this State upon the books of the Treasury, to an amount less than the sum so due and claimed, to deduct the sum so due to the State from the amount demanded, and to pay the difference only; and if the amount due to the State shall be equal to, or exceed the sum so demanded, the said Treasurer is directed to withold the entire amount.

Deduct or SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That in case the demand withhold. is made by any assignee of a party, having a claim as aforesaid against this State, the same right to deduct or withhold, as the case may be, shall exist as if the demand were made by the assignor,
