

CHAPTER 146.

CHAP. 147.

An act authorising and directing the County Commissioners of Cecil County, to levy a sum of money for the maintenance and support of Joseph Butler, an indigent invalid pauper, in said County.

Passed Feb. 24, 1846.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the county commissioners of Cecil county are hereby authorised and directed to levy annually, on the assessable property in said county, the sum of thirty dollars, to be placed in the hands of James Moore or some other proper person, for the maintenance and support of Joseph Butler, an indigent invalid pauper in the said county.

Authorised to levy.

CHAPTER 147.

A supplement to an act for the relief of certain Mechanics and others, of Howard District of Anne Arundel County, passed at December session, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, chapter three hundred and thirty-two.

Passed Feb. 24, 1846.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of tax of Howard District be, and they are hereby authorised and directed to levy on the assessable property of said district, such sums of money as may be necessary to pay the interest now due, or that may hereafter become due on the existing debts, contracted on account of work done and materials furnished for the public buildings of said district.

Authorised to levy.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid, are hereby authorised and directed to levy annually on the assessable property of said district, the sum of two thousand dollars, as provided for in the original act, to which this is a supplement, and for the purposes therein mentioned, until the existing debts, principal and interest, contracted for and on account of the public buildings of said district as aforesaid, be fully satisfied and paid.

Annually two thousand dollars.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That all parts of the original act, to which this is a supplement, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.
