Legal capacity.

Preamble.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the corporation and their successors, by the name and title aforesaid, shall be forever thereafter, capable in law, to sue and be sued, plead and be pleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended, in all or any court of justice, and before all and any judges, officers or persons whatsoever, in all and singular actions, matters or demands whatsoever.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall and may be lawful, for the said corporation, to have a common seal, for their use, and the same at their will and pleasure, to change, alter and make anew, from time to time as they may think best, and shall in general, have and exercise, all such rights, privileges and immunities, as by law are incident or necessary to corporations, and what may be necessary to the incorporation herein constituted, and to enable the members of said order to exercise all things concerning the design of this corporation, for the benevolent relief of the sick and distressed, and for the promotion of their purposes generally.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That it shall and may be lawful at any time for the General Assembly to demand a statement of the amount of the property, real and personal, belonging to the said corporation, and of the debts due to and from the said corporation, and the purposes for which disbursements shall have been made, and shall also have the right to authorise one or more persons to inspect such general accounts in the books of the corporation as shall relate to such statements.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act of incorporation shall enure for thirty years from the date of its passage, and that the General Assembly of Maryland reserves the right to change, alter or annul the same at any time.
