

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, CHAP. 161.

That the lines of the seventh election district of Carroll county shall run with the county road called the Nicodemus road, to Morgan's run, thence up said run to the centre of the county road leading from the Stone Meeting House to the Washington road, then by the centre of said road to the said Washington road.

CHAPTER 161.

An act to incorporate the Saint Alphonsus Roman Catholic diebesband, in the City of Baltimore. Passed Feb. 14, 1846.

WHEREAS, John G. Fledderman, William Weber, Johann Albert, William Mualler, Heinrich Schmalbrock, Gerhard Debring, Joseph Kuhn, and Martin Friedrich, of the city of Baltimore, have by their petition to this General Assembly, set forth that they and others have formed themselves into a beneficial society, for mutual relief, and have prayed to be incorporated; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Incorporated.

That the said John G. Fleddermann, William Webber, Johann Albert, William Mualler, Heinrich Schmalbroch, Gerhard Debring, Joseph Kuhn, and Martin Friendrick, their associates and successors, be, and they are hereby created a body corporate, by the name and style of Saint Alphonsus Roman Catholic diebesband; and by that name, shall have perpetual succession, sue and be sued, implead, and be impleaded; and shall have power and authority to make and use a corporate seal; to have, hold, take, sell, lease and convey any estate in lands, and any personal chattels, rights or credits; provided, the annual income of the said society, from its property and estate, shall not exceed the sum of one thousand dollars, and all beyond that amount shall be forfeited to the use of this State; and the said corporation shall have power and authority, as the members thereof shall hereafter order and direct, to make and form a constitution and ordain by-laws for its rule and government; and do and perform all other acts and things usual and proper in similar cases; provided, always, that the said corporation shall not at any time make, contrive, issue or utter, any note, token or device, as and for, or to be used in place or in stead of a currency or money; and provided further, that the
