An act to provide for the Inspection of Lumber at Perry- Passed Feb. ville, in Cecil County. 13, 1846.

SECTION 1. Ie it enacted by the General Assembly of Appoint mea-Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, surer and inthe Governor shall, with the advice and consent of the spector of lum-Senate, appoint annually one measurer and inspector of lumber for the town of Perryville, in Cecil county; said inspector not to appoint more than four deputies.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said measurer and in- Oath or affirspector, and also his deputies, before they enter upon the mation. execution of their offices shall take each and subscribe the following oath or affirmation as the case may be, before some justice of the peace of Cecil county, who shall register the same in his docket: I do solemnly swear or affirm, that I will faithfully, truly and impartially, according to the best of my skill and understanding, execute, do and perform the office and duty of measurer and inspector of lumber, without favor, affection, partiality or prejudice, according to the true intent and meaning of the laws of this State, relative to the same, so help me God.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said measurer Measure and and inspector shall measure and inspect all lumber arri- inspect. ving at Perryville, intended for consumption in Cecil county, not previously inspected in said county, nor manufactured therein; if any lumber shall arrive at Perryville, intended for exportation or reshipment, the said inspector shall, at the request of the owner thereof, mea-
