

CHAP. 21. sued, plead and be impleaded, and have a common seal and the same at their pleasure alter, and be entitled to use the powers and privileges incident to such corporation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said corporation shall have power to take and hold real and personal property not exceeding \$20,000, twenty thousand dollars, which property shall never be divided among the members of the said corporation, but shall descend to their successors to be applied for the relief of sick and distressed members of said corporation, the education of the children of deceased members, and for the promotion of these objects generally.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the corporation aforesaid shall have power to alter and amend the bye-laws thereof at pleasure, provided that such alteration and amendment do not in any way conflict with the laws of the State of Maryland, the laws of the United States, or the laws of the Grand Division of the Sons of Temperance of the State of Maryland.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the said corporation shall not be allowed to issue any note, token, device, scrip or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That this act of incorporation shall enure for forty years from the passage thereof, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter and annul the same at pleasure.

CHAPTER 21.

Passed Jan. 14, 1846. *An act to alter and change the names of Thomas Marsh Forman Bryan, and Florida Bryan, his wife, to Thomas Marsh Forman, and Florida Bryan Forman.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the names of Thomas Marsh Forman Bryan, and the name of Florida Bryan his wife, be and the same are hereby changed and altered to those of Thomas Marsh Forman and Florida Bryan Forman, and it shall and may be lawful for the said Thomas Marsh Forman Bryan and Florida Bryan his wife, at all times hereafter to be called and known by and use the names of Thomas Marsh Forman and Florida Bryan Forman, and by the said names to contract, sell, purchase, convey
