And be it enacted, That so much of the second section of the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter twenty-four, as limits the sum to be paid to the treasurer by said agents, to two dollars on every hundred dollars of the premiums received by them, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that from and after the first day of May next, the said agents respectively shall in addition to the license money by this act required to be paid by them, pay into the treasury the sum of three dollars on every hundred dollars of premiums received by them, at the same time and in the same manner as is directed by the said original act.
