SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Time allowed. of Maryland, That Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector of Prince George's county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any tax or balances of taxes, now remaining due and uncollected by him, in the same manner as he could, or might have done within the time limited by law.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this law shall not be In force 1 year in force longer than one year from the passage thereof.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said Thomas M. D. Baden, before he proceeds to execute the property of any person by the authority of this act, shall deliver or cause to be delivered to the person or persons chargeable with the same, and at least ten days before he shall proceed to execute as aforesaid, a particular account of the sum demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit thereto annexed, that he hath not, nor hath any person acting under him, whilst collector as aforesaid, or since then, received any part thereof or satisfaction for the same, to the best of his knowledge and belief; provided, Proviso that nothing in this act contained, shall be so construed to affect the estate of a deceased person, except to authorise the said Thomas M. D. Baden to recover any claim or balance due by a deceased person, in the same manner that claims against deceased persons are now recovered by law.
