

CHAP. 175. eighteen hundred and twenty eight, in Liber. J. S., No. 29, folios 508 & 509, one of the land records of Frederick County, be and the same is hereby declared valid to all intents and purposes, as if said acknowledgment had been made and taken in strict conformity to law.

Made good.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all title or titles derived under or by virtue of said deed be, and the same are hereby made good, notwithstanding the defects in said acknowledgment; *provided,* that in all other respects the said deed shall have been executed in due conformity to law.

CHAPTER 174.

Passed Feb. 23, 1846.

An act to make valid the acknowledgment of a deed from Esther Hughes to Peter Spessart.

Made valid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the deed from Easter Hughes to Peter Spessart, now deceased, bearing date October twentyseven, eighteen hundred and forty, and recorded in Liber. W. W. folios 671, 672 and 673 of the land records of Washington county, shall be considered, and the same is hereby declared to be as valid and effectual to all intents and purposes, as if the acknowledgment thereof had been made and certified in due form of law.
