And be it enacted, That the provisions of this Applicable to act, and of the original act to which this is a supplement, more and Harshall apply to, and be in full force and effect in Carroll ford counties. county, Baltimore county and Harford county; and such provisions of said original act and this supplement as refer to Baltimore city and county courts, shall refer to Carroll, Baltimore and Harford county courts.

CHAPTER 177.

An act to incorporate the subscribers to the Warfield Academy in Howard District, in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Body corpo-Maryland, 'That all persons who now are, or may hereafter become subscribers to the capital stock intende dto be raised for the building or establishment of an academy near Cooksville in Howard District, shall be, and they are hereby made and constituted a body politic and corporate by the name, style and title of the Warfield Academy, and by that name, style and title, shall have continued succession, and be able and capable in law to acquire property, real, personal and mixed, by gift, devise or purchase, and to hold, sell, dispose of, and convey
