CHAPTER 178.

An act to incorporate the Holy and Friendship Society in the city of Baltimore.

Incorporated.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Jacob Naipmunn, Gerson Seifensieder, Lazarus Hirseh, Lot Kimel, Solomon May, David Rosenstak, Isaac Simpson, Lot Lowenthal, Solomon Klein, Abraham Grunesvald, Simpson Reis, Kron Frederick, Israel Wopfsahat, Solomon Schulhen, Abraham Berliner, Anset Ticter, Falh Simpson, Samuel Straws, Tobias Hery, Abraham Bamberger and others, officers and members of the Holy and Friendship Society of Baltimore, be and they are hereby incorporated and made a body corporate and politic, by the name of the Holy and Friendship Society of Baltimore, and by that name, may sue and be sued, plead and beimpleaded, answer and defend, and be answered and defended, in all courts of law and equity, and have a common seal, and may alter the same at their pleasure, and be entitled to the favor and privileges incident to such corporations.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said corporation shall be capable of taking and holding real and personal estate, not exceeding in value, the sum of ten thousand dollars, for the benevolent relief of the sick and distressed, the education of the orphans of its members, and for the promotion of those persons generally.

Corporate powers

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said corporation shall and may at all times hereafter be capable in law, to have, receive and retain to its members and their successors, devises or bequests of any person or persons, bodies corporate or politic, capable of making the same and the same at their pleasure to transfer or dispose of in such manner as they may think proper.

Power to alter and amend.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall have power to alter and amend their by-laws at pleasure; provided, they do not conflict with the laws of the State, or the laws of the United States.

Proviso.

Issues forbid

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall not be permitted to issue any note, token, device or script or other evidence of debt to be used as a currency.

Enure for 40 years.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act of incorporation shall inure for the period of forty years from its passage, and that the legislature reserves to itself the right to alter or annul this act of incorporation at pleasure.
