SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Authorised to Maryland, That the commissioners of tax, of Carroll levy. county be, and are hereby authorised and required to levy on the assessable property of said county, at the usual time of making the county levy, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, such sum of money as the said commissioners may deem sufficient to defray the expenses which have been, or may be incurred by the attendance of State witnesses at Carroll county court during the present or previous year.
