CHAPTER 25.

*An act to allow Patrick O'Neill, recent collector of Frederick county, further time to complete his collections.* Passed Jan. 7, 1846.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the time limited by law, within which Patrick O'Neill, recent collector of Frederick county, should have made his collections, be, and the same is hereby further extended to the first day of August, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-six. Time extended.

CHAPTER 26.

*An act to provide for the benefit of the State Witnesses, of Carroll county.* Passed Jan. 8, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of tax, of Carroll county be, and are hereby authorised and required to levy on the assessable property of said county, at the usual time of making the county levy, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, such sum of money as the said commissioners may deem sufficient to defray the expenses which have been, or may be incurred by the attendance of State witnesses at Carroll county court during the present or previous year. Authorised to levy.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the said commissioners to levy as aforesaid, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, and annually thereafter, such sum of money as they may deem sufficient to pay all the State witnesses who may be legally summoned to testify in behalf of the State, at any county court between their annual levy. Duty of commissioners.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the sum or sums of money directed to be levied, by virtue of this act, shall Duty of collector, &c.
