

CHAP. 194.

Duty of commissioner of stamps, &c.

5th, 6th, 7th and 8th sections of the original act taken as parts of this act.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the commissioner of stamps and the other officers mentioned in the act to which this act is a supplement, in all respects to execute this act as by the said original act was prescribed and directed, and to account with and pay into the treasury all sums of money which may be received by them respectively, in virtue of this act, under all the penalties prescribed by the original act, and at the periods fixed by law for that purpose.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth sections of the original act, shall be deemed and taken as parts of this act, as fully to every intent and purpose, as if the provisions of the said sections were incorporated herein, except that the periods fixed by the said fifth section for the commissioner of stamps to account with, and pay into the treasury the monies received by him, shall be regulated according to the law applicable to the duties of the clerks in that respect.
