SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assemby of Authorised to Maryland, That William Hilleary and Richard G. Cross, collect. administrators of William Thomas, deceased, late deputy sheriff of Prince Gerge's county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to collect by execution, and receive all and every balance or amount of officer fees, chancery taxes, fines and forfeitures, and all other sums which were due to and remained uncollected by the said William Thomas, as deputy sheriff of Prince
