## CHAPTER 198.

An act for building a Bridge over Deer Creek, at William Passed Mar. Pyles' Saw-mill, or at or near the old Ford leading from 4, 1846. Bel-Air to Mrs. Brown's.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Appoint three Maryland, That the county commissioners for Harford commissioners county may appoint three persons of experience, as bridge commissioners, to fix upon a site at William Pyles' saw mill, or at or near the old ford leading from Bel-Air to Mrs. Brown's, for building a bridge over Deer Creek, and the said commissioners are hereby authorised to erect, or cause to be erected, a good and substantial bridge, with two stone abutments, and one or more piers, Erect bridge, as the building commissioners shall think best, to be raised sufficiently high to save the bridge in time of freshets; the bridge to be weather-boarded, and covered in with cedar or pine shingles, and done in a workmanlike manner, and for a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the commissioners of Authorised to Harford county are hereby authorised and empowered, if levy. they deem it right and proper, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, at their next annual levy, a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars, and have the same levied and collected as other county levies are, and made payable to the said bridge commissioners.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the said bridge commissioners shall keep a fair and accurate account of their count of exexpenditures in erecting said bridge, and in case there penditures. should be any thing left after the same is finished, and the abutments filled in, they shall pay the same over to the county commissioners, to be by them applied to the use of the county.
