

may be lawful for any three or more patrons of any free school in Prince George's county, to appeal from the decision of the local trustees of said school, upon the appointment or removal of any teacher or teachers of said schools, to the general board of trustees of said free schools, and the decision of said general board of trustees shall be final and conclusive in the matter submitted to them by said appeal.

CHAP. 198.

CHAPTER 198.

*An act for building a Bridge over Deer Creek, at William Pyles' Saw-mill, or at or near the old Ford leading from Bel-Air to Mrs. Brown's.* Passed Mar. 4, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners for Harford county may appoint three persons of experience, as bridge commissioners, to fix upon a site at William Pyles' saw mill, or at or near the old ford leading from Bel-Air to Mrs. Brown's, for building a bridge over Deer Creek, and the said commissioners are hereby authorised to erect, or cause to be erected, a good and substantial bridge, with two stone abutments, and one or more piers, as the building commissioners shall think best, to be raised sufficiently high to save the bridge in time of freshets; the bridge to be weather-boarded, and covered in with cedar or pine shingles, and done in a workman-like manner, and for a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of Harford county are hereby authorised and empowered, if they deem it right and proper, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, at their next annual levy, a sum not exceeding eight hundred dollars, and have the same levied and collected as other county levies are, and made payable to the said bridge commissioners.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said bridge commissioners shall keep a fair and accurate account of their expenditures in erecting said bridge, and in case there should be any thing left after the same is finished, and the abutments filled in, they shall pay the same over to the county commissioners, to be by them applied to the use of the county.
