Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Publish annu-Maryland, That the commissioners of Somerset County ally a state-shall publish annually a fair full and accurate statement ceipts of all receipts and expenditures, of the twelve months next preceding the closing of the annual levy by said commissioners, in a paper printed in Princess Ann, giving said statement not less than three insertions in each paper, under the penalty of the forfeiture of the pay of the members belonging to the board of commissioners in said county, during the twelve months aforesaid, in case of their failure to make such publication.
