

CHAP. 220. the Treasury as other State taxes are collected and paid:

CHAPTER 219.

Passed Mar. 3, 1846. *An act supplemental to an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter two hundred and sixty-five.*

Altered and amended. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the third section of the act of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter two hundred and sixty-five, be and the same is hereby altered and amended, by the substitution of the words, one-ninth in lieu of the words one-tenth, after the words second district; by which said alteration and amendment, the second district will be entitled to one-ninth of the distribution of the school fund in Cecil county, instead of one-tenth of the same, as at present under the third section of the said act.
