SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Authorised to Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act levy. the levy court of Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, if they deem it expedient, to levy on the assessable property in said county, a sufficient sum, not exceeding six thousand dollars, to build a substantial bridge over the river Monocacy, at, or in the immediate vicinity of the ford, commonly known as Campbell's ford; provided, the said judges of the levy provided. court shall not levy more than two thousand dollars in any one year for the purpose of building said bridge.
