CHAPTER 264.

An act for the extension of the time of William Nevitt, Passed Mar.
collector of Charles county, for the payment of the Direct 2, 1846
and Income tax.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of* Time extend-
Maryland, That the time for the payment of the direct ed
and income tax, and all taxes due the State, for the years
eighteen hundred and forty three and eighteen hundred
and forty four, by William Nevitt, collector for Charles
county, be extended to the first day of January, eighteen
hundred and forty seven; *provided*, that the responsibili- Proviso.
ty of the sureties of the said William Nevitt, shall not be
affected thereby; the State reserving to itself all its rights
and remedies against said sureties, notwithstanding the
provisions of this act; *provided further*, that the said
sureties file their assent thereto in writing in the office of
the clerk of the said county, on or before the first day of
April next.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That no proceedings shall No proceed-
be had upon the bond of the said William Nevitt, col- ings on bond.
lector as aforesaid, until after the first day of January, in
the year eighteen hundred and forty seven; *provided*, Proviso.
the sureties of the said William Nevitt, give their assent
