

CHAP. 305.

Continue fifty years.

Right reserved.

Issues forbid.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act of incorporation shall continue and exist for fifty years from its passage, unless the General Assembly of Maryland should alter, amend or annul it, which right it reserves to the legislature to exercise at pleasure.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That nothing in this act shall be so taken or construed as to allow the said corporation to issue any note, token and scrip or device, to be used as a currency.

CHAPTER 304.

Passed Mar. 9, 1846.

Commissioners appointed.

Authorised to levy.

Give public notice.

An act to build a Bridge over Winter's Run at or near Hanways' Mill in Harford County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Thomas Bay, Thomas Howard and Joshua Amos be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to fix upon a site for a bridge over Winters' run at or near Hanways' mill, and when the said commissioners shall agree upon the site, they shall report the same to the county commissioners.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners of Harford county be, and they are hereby authorised and directed in their discretion, if they shall deem the same necessary, to levy upon the assessable property of said county at their first annual levy next after the passage of this act, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars for the building of said bridge.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the county commissioners to give public notice by advertisement in all the newspapers printed in Harford county, for at least three weeks, inviting proposals for building said bridge, and shall contract for the same on the best terms in their judgment for the public interest.
